Our Pre-School programs gradually introduce children to a more structured, school-like environment by blending a planned curriculum with interest-led activities. Pre-literacy skills and numeracy concepts are interwoven with opportunities for social and gross motor development.

School Age and Kindergarteners can play freely, complete homework or participate in organized group activities such as garden and cooking projects, music and drama clubs or fitness programs.

Our staff of Registered Early Childhood Educators and specialized instructors lead active programs enriched with art, music, fitness, and nature that motivate children to explore their talents and build friendships.

Enrichment activities such as Art, Cooking, Sports or Entrepreneurship are incorporated into the daily curriculum, according to interest, sometimes through special interest clubs.

## About Us


