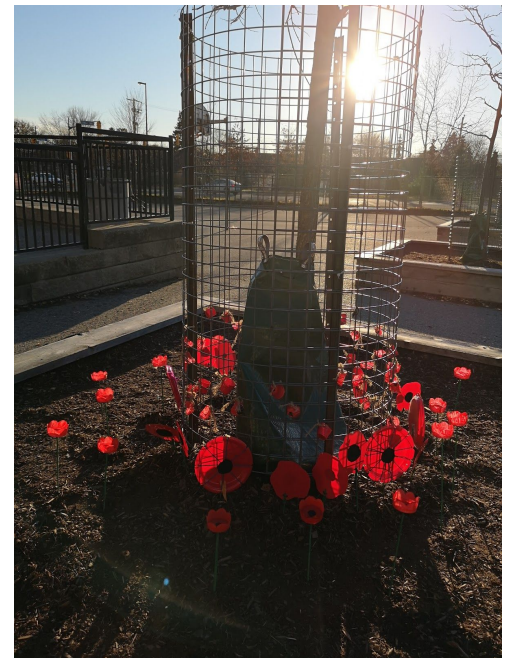


# Remembrance Day Project



Children from North York Little Prints - St Cyril worked on a variety of activities related to Remembrance Day. It soon became a child led project. We started off by doing indoor activities with the poppy. We then extended our experiences to the outdoors.



The children used yarn and paper plates to weave a poppy and we also used recyclable materials such as plastic egg cartons and plastic bottles to create little poppies. The children used paint to add a touch of colour. Once we were done, the children brainstormed ideas of what we can do with all these little poppies they made. One of the children came up with the idea of displaying the poppies around the tree outside.



A few of the children extended the activities further by creating 3D structures using the Plus Plus blocks. They had even started to create a short animation video showing two armies fighting and then one of the leaders came forward holding two poppies to bring peace. The poppies symbolize the soldiers that died in the war.
